Childcare organisations KinderRijk, Swazoom Kinderopvang, Akros and Impuls strengthen their strategic collaboration.

We join knowledge, expertise and strength for children's equal opportunities.

All children deserve a future where they can be the best version of themselves. Even children for whom such a promising future is not self-evident. Particularly those children often need some extra support to develop to their full potential. Safe, accessible and quality childcare plays a crucial role – as do early-childhood education and primary schools.

As we want to even further enhance children's equality of opportunity as social childcare organisations in Amsterdam and Amstelveen, we – KinderRijk, Swazoom Kinderopvang, Akros and Impuls – have agreed to strengthen each other wherever possible.
